



Code of Conduct

The Library prohibits the following activities and behaviors on its premises. Compliance with this Code is expected of patrons of all ages.

- Committing or attempting to commit a violation of any federal, state, or local ordinance.
- Use of controlled substances, smoking, or other use of tobacco or e-cigarette products.
- Drinking alcoholic beverages, except for in Library-sponsored programs.
- Engaging in sexual conduct or lewd behavior.
- Using Library property in a destructive or dangerous manner.
- Engaging in conduct that disrupts the operation of the Library, or disturbs staff and patrons.
- Use of any communication or entertainment devices at a volume that disturbs others.
- Soliciting or canvassing without express permission of the Library staff.
- Interfering with the free passage of Library staff or users in or onto Library premises.
- Parking vehicles on Library premises for purposes other than library use.
- Sleeping on Library property.
- Unhygienic behavior.
- Entering the Library with bare feet or bare chest.
- Disobeying the reasonable direction of Library staff members.

The following guidelines also apply to youth patrons:

- Youth (ages 0-17) are not allowed while school is in session, unless they are accompanied by a parent, guardian, or tutor.
- Children under the age of nine must be accompanied by an adult, except as approved for Library programs.
- Guardians are responsible for the behavior of their children in the Library, whether or not the guardian is present.

Violators of the Code of Conduct are subject to disciplinary procedures.
